Angelo Trunzo and his team are out to change the community around them through Harvest House Fellowship church plant in Sebring. With his ten years of pastoral experience, Angelo is ready for this next step in his life and ministry. As of now, Harvest House has approximately twenty committed members, all who attended the church's first service on December 10, 2017.

The mission of Harvest House Fellowship is to build relationships with unchurched families through Christ-centered teaching, quality worship, compassionate care, personal discipleship, and servant leadership. This will offer purpose and dignity among people while empowering them along with the community in which they live and serve.

After an extended amount of time of meeting in homes, Angelo and his team had a desire and calling to move somewhere more permanent. With this in mind, they were finally able to start meeting at a county park with onsite facilities. Though this is not the long term solution, Pastor Angelo considers it a great blessing to be in a central location where they can hold services and reach out to the community at the same time.

They continue to be in prayer for a more permanent meeting location, all while asking the question, "What is best for the Kingdom?"

CHURCH RENEWAL SPOTLIGHT CROSTOWN FELLOWSHIP | PORT ST. LUCIE, FL

Pastor John Croft arrived in Port St. Lucie in June of 2017 to approximately thirteen people attending Crosstown Fellowship Church. In just six months the number of attendees has more than doubled with now an average of thirty-five to forty people. This past year has been one of excitement and steps of faith as people of the church have spent much time in prayer and fasting, asking God for vision and focus. In the fall of 2017, the church hosted a Fall Festival where they had the opportunity to reach over 200 people in their community. Pastor Croft along with his team are currently in the process of planning events for 2018 including a Summer Art Camp. Also in the planning is a missions trip for Crosstown Fellowship that is expected to occur in the fall of this year. The mission of Crosstown comes from Matthew 22:37-39 where Jesus is giving the greatest commandment to love God and love each other. The people of Crosstown Fellowship are striving to live this mission out and as a result, as Pastor John Croft put it, "God has been giving us favor in the community." OVERSEAS PARTNERSHIP DR. SHELTON WOOD | GUYANA

Imagine yourself growing up in a poor country where finding the essentials can be a difficult challenge and having practically no hope for succeeding at your lifelong dream of becoming a counselor. Now imagine somebody inviting you to go to college with scholarships provided from a church district in another country. This is exactly what the Florida District plays a part in when it comes to helping the country of Guyana. Leading the way in this endeavor is Dr. Shelton Wood who will be traveling to Guyana the last two weeks of February to help future counselors obtain their degrees in a PHD or Masters program. Following their schooling in the Wesleyan Bible college, the students will intern under a licensed counselor for six to nine months. The classes themselves have the same amount of emphasis as the classes taken here in the States. The students are also tested to see which area of counseling they would best be suited for. There are eight different types of counseling and a personality profile created by Dr. Wood will help determine which area a student will both enjoy and be most helpful in. LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT DR. PHIL GRAY | ONLINE DISTRICT EXTENSION CLASSES

In 2014, the Florida District Ministerial Institute started teaching online classes. Dr. Phil Gray teaches these online classes while students make their way toward ordination or other desired ministerial accomplishment. The district ministerial scholarship program financially helps students who cannot afford to take these classes. So far the ministerial institute has had the opportunity to help approximately forty-five people since 2014. One of these students is Rafael Bellini who received help for ordination and is now a Florida District church planter and pastor of The Send Church in Spring Hill.
