

CHURCH PLANTING SPOTLIGHT FERNANDO MARTINEZ | FT. MYERS



Pastor Fernando Martinez has been in full time ministry for twenty-six years, most of which has taken place in Colombia South America until December 10th of last year when Pastor Fernando and his family moved to the states to plant a church in Ft. Myers, Florida. Pastor Fernando says, "My family and I were saddened on New Year's Eve as we had just arrived in the U.S. and were completely alone in a country with a language and culture unknown to us. After talking to my wife, we began to think that leaving Colombia to come to the U.S. may have been a bad idea. Then just as we were about to leave the house, a car pulled up in the parking lot which drew my attention. A young Colombian man called me from inside the car. I went to his window as he greeted me very kindly and introduced me to his mother who was very troubled and asked us for prayer in her favor. This was the first person who we were able to minister to and pray for in our neighborhood." Right now Pastor Fernando is in the process of adapting to Florida culture and language; but even this is not stopping him from making contact with neighbors and classmates and experiencing ministry first hand such as the story shared above. Their church, Catedral Cristiana de la Familia, has not started services yet, but have been meeting with people in their home for Bible Study and prayer during the last month. They hope to start services within the next two to three months from the people who they have met through their neighborhood and ESL Classes they have been taking.

CHURCH RENEWAL SPOTLIGHT

MIKE LEVELLE | LEESBURG, FL

Trying to decide whether or not to close the doors of a church is a step that is not taken lightly. Pastor Mike Levelle and his wife arrived in Leesburg in late September of 2016 to help evaluate whether this work had possibility for the future. Supplying the pulpit for the church for ten months while having six people attending services, the decision was made to find a way to re-develop this church. The first step was to be able to get the pastor living in the community. Since the church did not have a parsonage, the decision was made to remodel the first floor of the church to create a space to serve as a parsonage. As of October 2017, the remodel work was completed and Pastor Mike was able to make the move onsite. Step two was to take care of major delayed maintenance items at the church facility which included replacement of A/C's and the putting on of a new roof. While this has been taking place over the past six months, this small hand full of people began to see a few new folks join them and now their attendance averages between fifteen to twenty people on Sunday mornings. The mission of Community Wesleyan Church is to make disciples who make disciples. Pastor Mike strives to implement this mission into the church small group studies and in his sermons on Sunday mornings. Pray for Pastor Mike and the redevelopment of this church in Leesburg FL.
