What to Bring Checklist

- Bible
- Sleeping Bag/Twin Sheet Set
- Pillow
- Insect Repellent
- Toiletries (Soap, Deodorant, Shampoo, etc.)
- Towels and Washcloths
- Jacket/Raincoat
- Closed-toed Shoes (2 Pairs recommended)
- Flashlight
- Money for Snack Shack (Up to \$25)
- Swimsuit (Modest one-piece for girls)

What NOT to Bring

- Immodest clothing (your counselor may ask you to change your attire if deemed inappropriate)
- Fireworks
- Weapons (including pocket knife)
- Alcohol and Tobacco Products
- Drug Paraphernalia of any kind
- Lighters/Matches
- Cell phones are discouraged. They will be confiscated if it is a distraction

Additional Notes

Please fill out the medical release form and the over-the-counter medication form prior to getting to camp. This form will need to be notarized as well. Upon arrival, the forms must be given to the camp nurse at the registration table.

All medications should be packed separately in a labeled zip lock bag. They must be given to the camp nurse upon arrival for registration.

Any unauthorized items may be confiscated and returned upon departure. Campers should not bring any non-essential items to camp. Label all valuables and clothing for identification in case they get misplaced or lost.
